

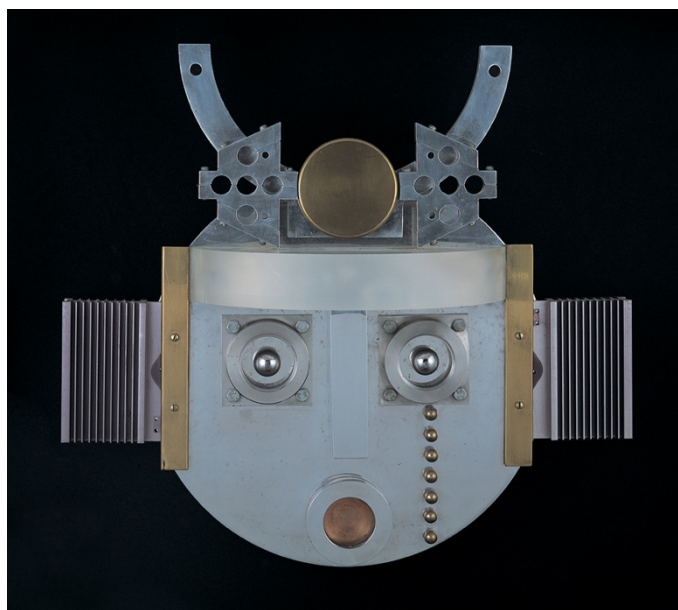
Tony Price – Atomic Art

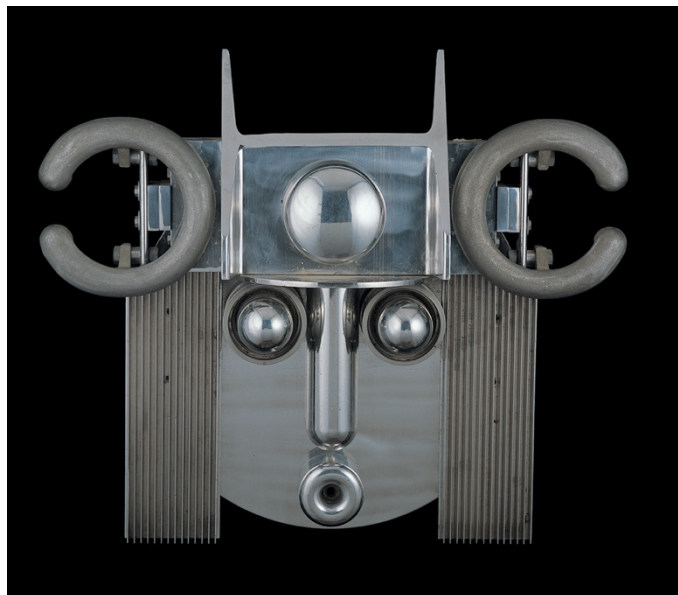

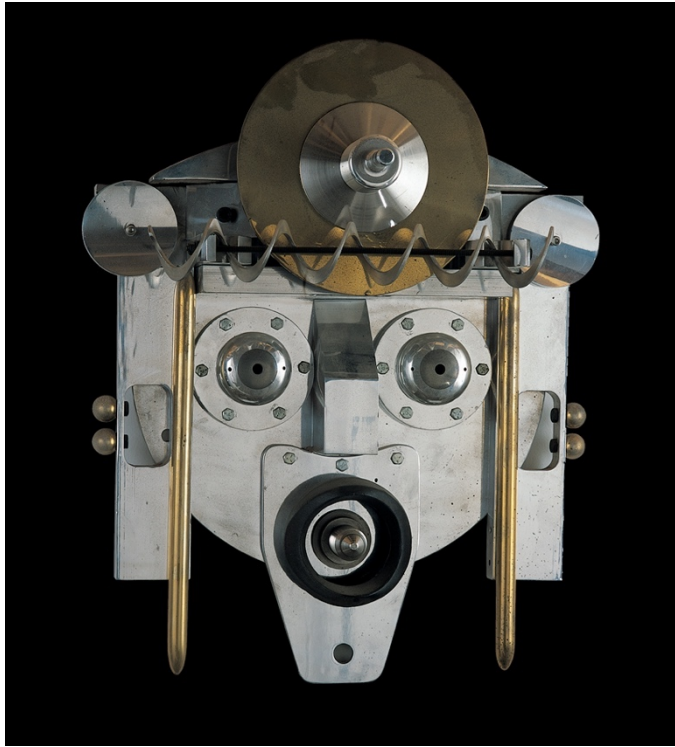

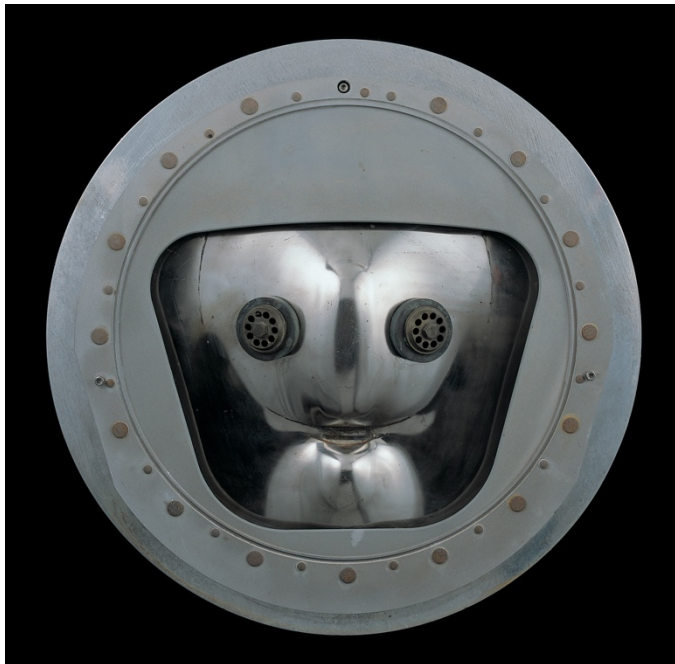

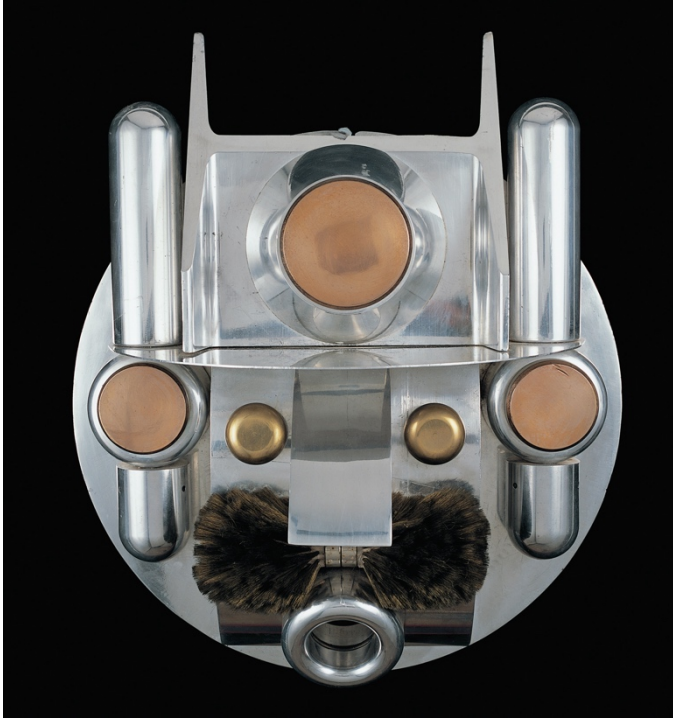

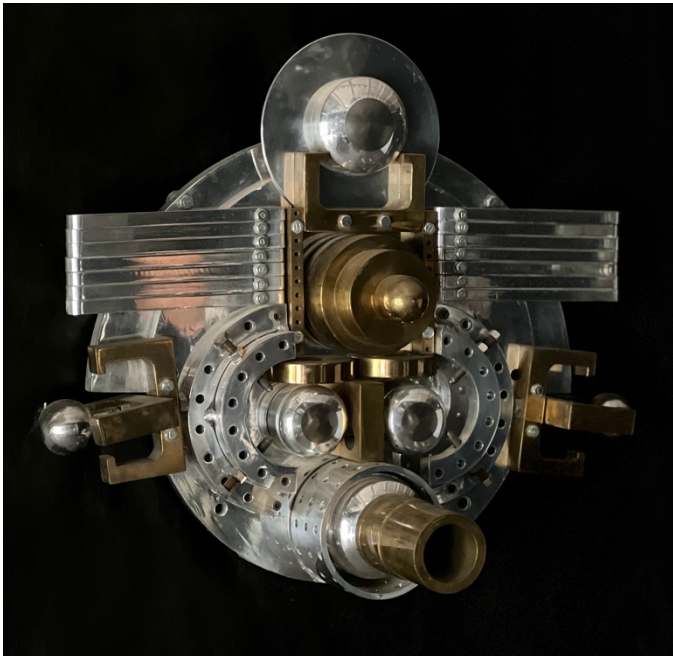

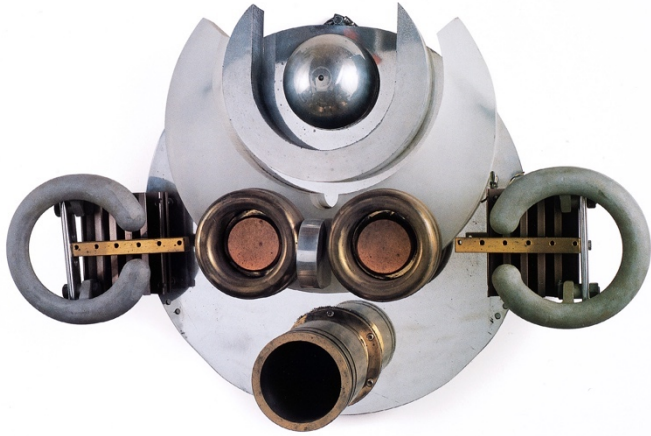

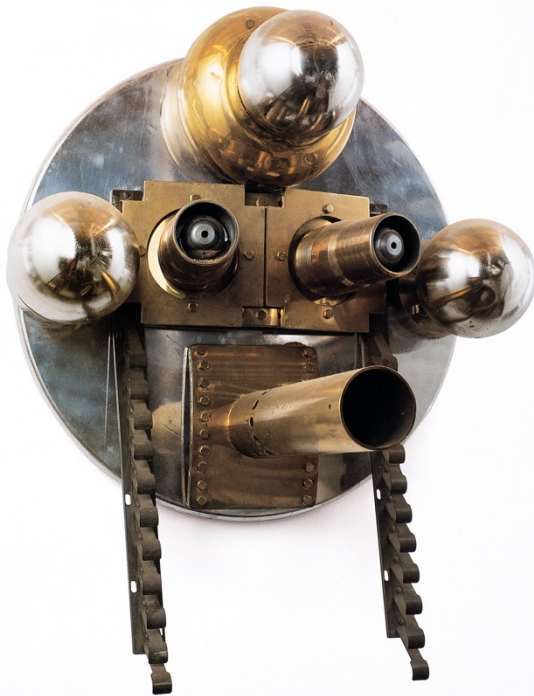

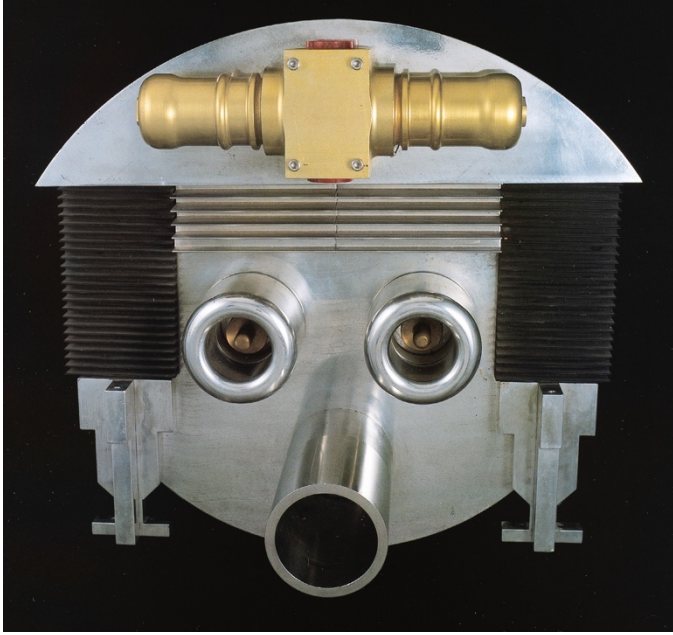

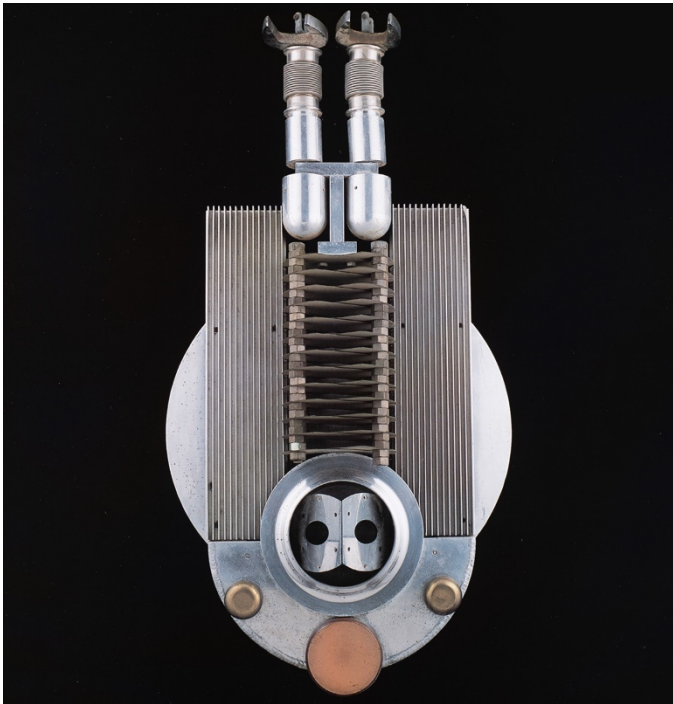

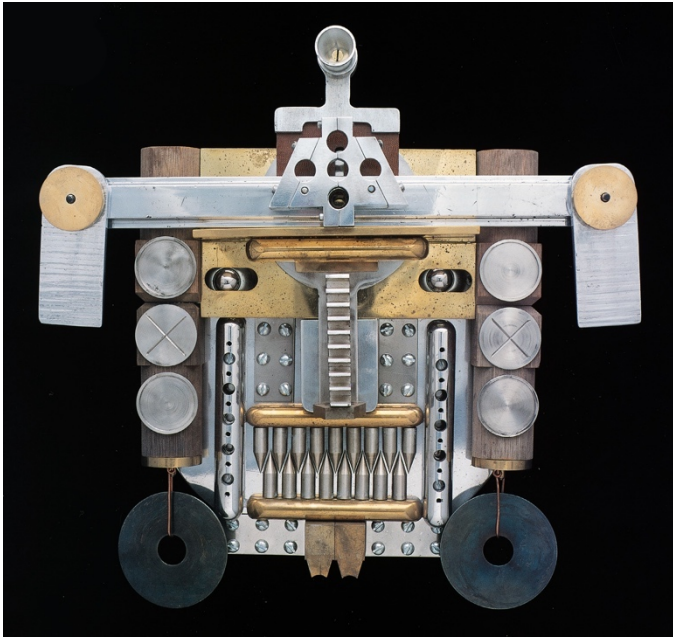

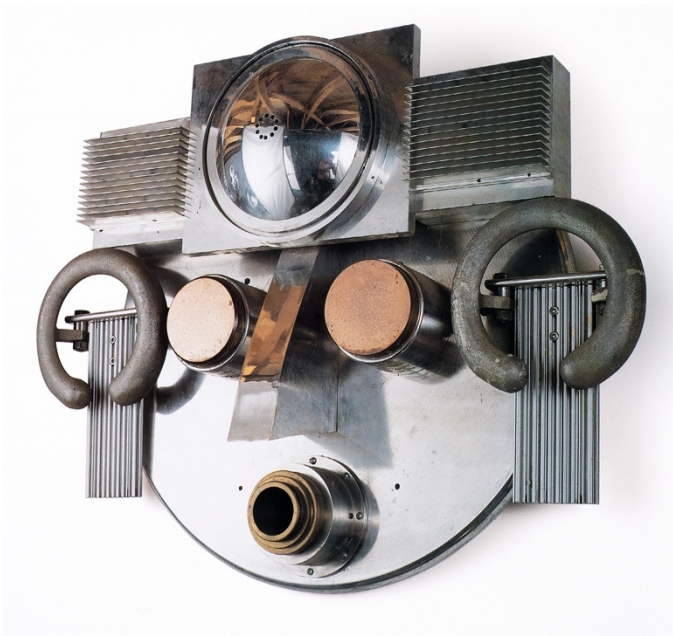

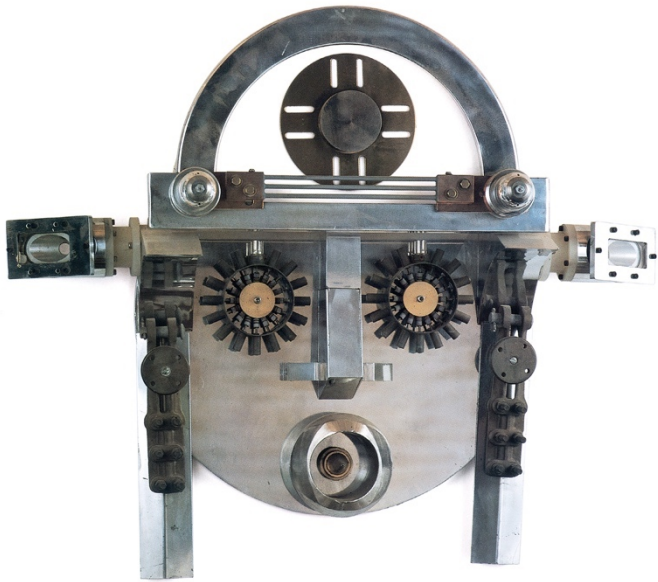

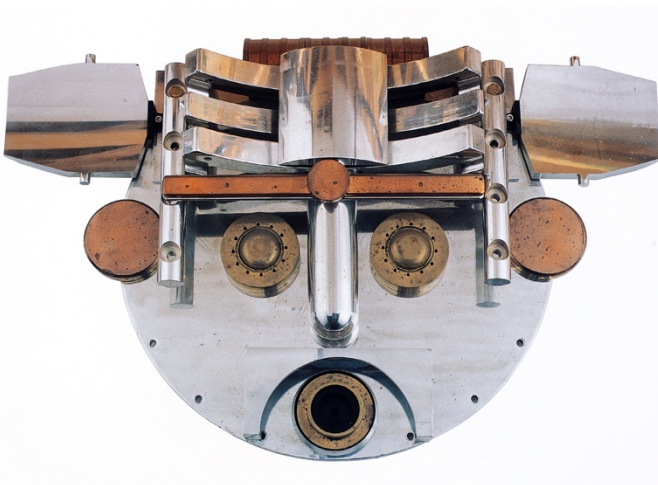

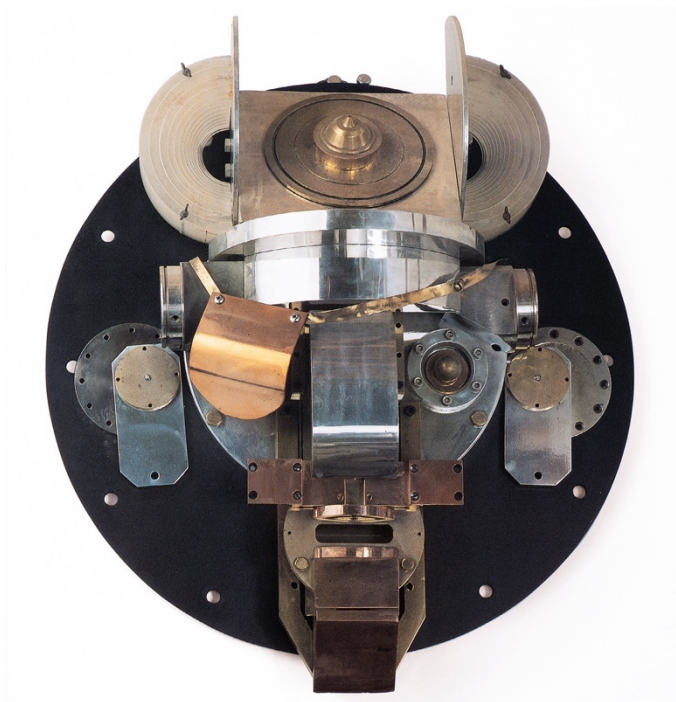

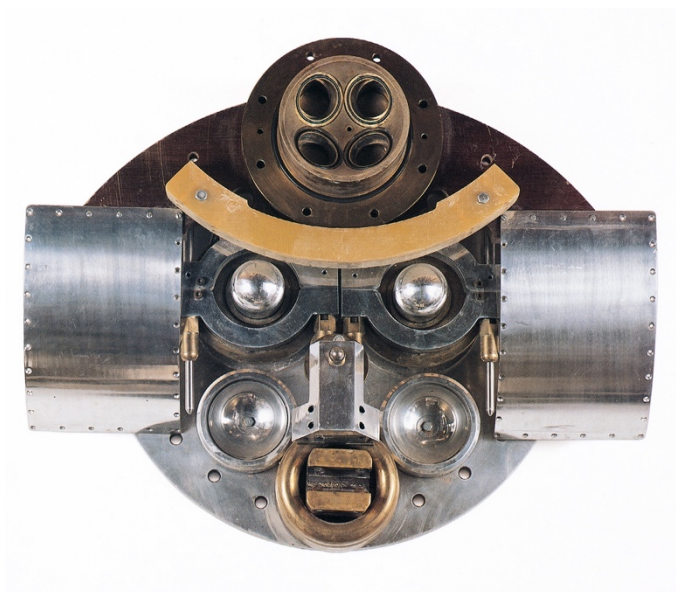

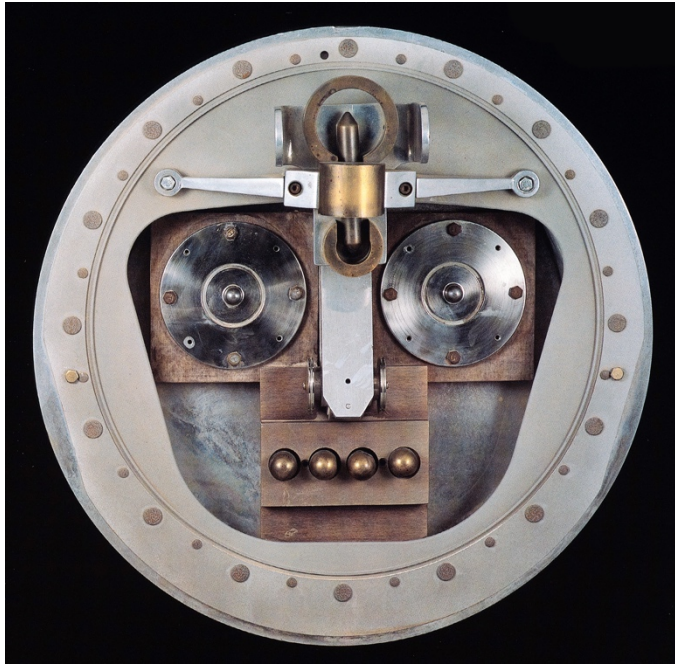

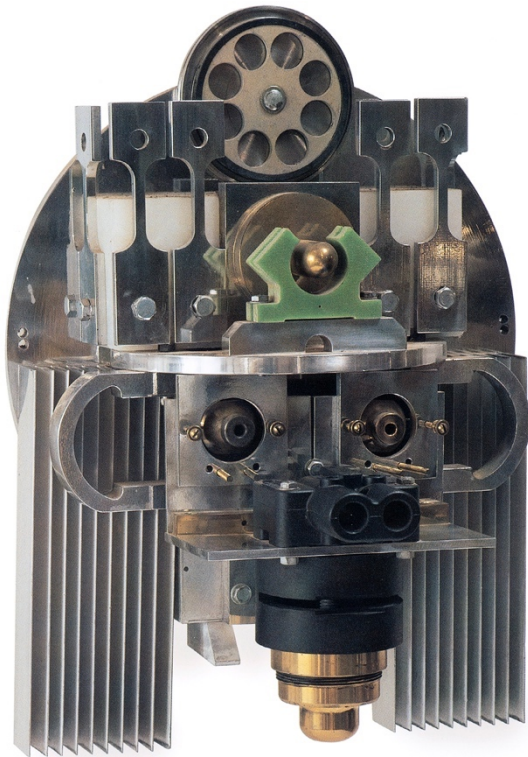
